



How to make overlays to use with the Internet

You can create overlays that let students go directly to web sites. If you want to put graphics from web sites onto your overlay you must save these as .bmp files first - [see separate sheet](#).

To make an overlay:

1. Run your browser, e.g. **Internet Explorer**, and **Concept Plus Editor**.
2. Run **Concept Plus Editor** and drag out an area for your first web link.
3. Type a name, e.g. Eastenders, into the **Enter text for overlay** box.
4. Use the **Graphics** button to add a graphic if you want one on your printed overlay.
5. Now display your **browser** (click on the icon at the bottom of the screen).
6. Go to the web site you want to link to.
7. Highlight the address line ([www.etc](#)) by clicking in it.
8. Hold down the **Ctrl** key on your keyboard and press **C**. This will copy the address to your clipboard.
9. Display **Concept Plus Editor** again.
10. Click the **Send** tab.
11. Click the **Keys** button.
12. Choose **Alt** from the list of keys.
13. Click in the **When chosen send box** and type **FO** on your keyboard.
14. Hold down the **Ctrl** key on your keyboard and press **V**. This will copy the address in your clipboard.
15. Click the **Keys** button again and choose **Enter** then click **OK**.
16. Repeat for more web links.
17. Save and print when you have finished

To use your overlay

1. Run your browser and **Concept Plus Driver**.
2. Choose your overlay file from the **Concept Plus Driver** file menu.
3. Display your browser.
4. Press the **Concept Keyboard** to go to a web site.
