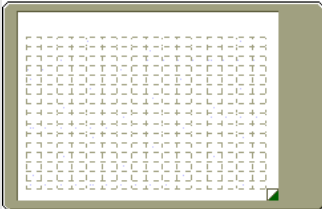





Adding pictures to Concept Plus

Concept Plus Editor lets you create and print overlays that are illustrated with pictures or photos. Before you do this you must know where your pictures are saved. Concept Plus Editor can handle pictures that are saved as bitmaps or Windows metafiles. These are files that end with .bmp, .wmf or .emf.

To add pictures to an overlay



1. **Concept Editor** Double click on the **Concept Plus Editor** icon or choose it from the **Programs** list. A **Concept Keyboard** will be displayed on screen.

2.  Now use the mouse to drag out an area on the displayed **Concept Keyboard**. The **Block Contents** dialog box will open. (Alternatively click the **File** menu and choose **New** then choose a layout which will be displayed. Now double click in a block and the **Block Contents** dialog box will open).

3. Click on the **Graphic** button then locate and select your picture.
4. Click on **Open**.
5. Type any text you want to add to your picture into the text box.
6. When you have finished click **OK**.
7. Repeat for subsequent pictures.
8. When you have finished choose **Save As...** from the **File** menu to save your overlay.
9. Now print your overlay and exit from **Concept Plus Editor**.
10. Run **Concept Plus Driver** to use your overlay.

Printing your overlay

Concept Plus Editor will print out overlays in A3. To do this you must make sure that you have created the overlay for an A3 board. Click the **File** menu, then click **Information** to check.

To create an overlay for an A3 board, click the **File** menu, then click **New** and choose an A3 board from the list.

If you have an A3 printer set the paper size to A3 and the paper orientation to landscape.

If you have an A4 printer it will print on 3 sheets. Set the paper orientation to portrait.
