

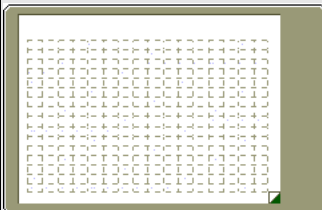


## Tactile Overlays with Concept Plus

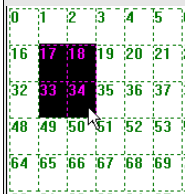
Concept Plus is the software that lets you create and use Concept Keyboard overlays. It comes in 2 parts; Concept Plus Driver for using overlays and Concept Plus Editor for creating overlays. You can use Concept Plus Editor to create tactile overlays that will play back recorded sound when pressed. Begin by recording your sounds ([see separate sheet](#)) and saving them as .wav files.

### To create an overlay with sounds

When you have created the overlay using suitable tactile materials you need to create an overlay file with sound.



1. **Concept Editor** Double click on the **Concept Plus Editor** icon or choose it from the **Programs** list. A Concept Keyboard will be displayed on screen.



2. Now use the mouse to drag out an area on the displayed Concept Keyboard. The **Block Contents** dialog box will open. (Alternatively click the **File** menu and choose **New** then choose a layout which will be displayed. Now double click in a block and the **Block Contents** dialog box will open).

3. Click on the **Hear** tab then locate and select your sound file. (This must be a .wav file.)
4. Click on **OK**.
5. Repeat for subsequent sounds.
6. When you have finished choose **Save As...** from the **File** menu to save your overlay.
7. Now print your overlay and exit from **Concept Plus Editor**.
8. Run **Concept Plus** [to use your overlay](#).
